The Approved Resources List contains the made-in Nunavut resources and the curriculum and resources from other sources that are approved for use in Nunavut schools. Please provide a copy of the list and the letter to each teacher so that they are aware of what is available to them and what is expected of them regarding program planning.

The Department of Education expectation is that classroom teachers must use the identified curriculum and resources on the accompanying list as the basis for program planning and instruction. It is the responsibility of the principal to ensure that the curriculum and resources are available for staff and organized for easy access.

The Curriculum and School Services website is being revised to enable teachers to access documents easily in electronic formats. As part of establishment of a new Teaching and Learning Centre in Iqaluit, work is also underway to determine a publication source to provide additional hard copies of the approved resources.
